SECURITY

cPMT, Inc. takes every precaution to protect user's information. When users submit information via the website it is protected both online and off-line. When the subscription form asks users to enter sensitive information (such as credit card #) that information is encrypted and is protected with the best encryption software in the industry – SSL. While on a secure page, such as the order form, the lock icon on the bottom of the web browser such as Netscape Navigator or Microsoft Internet Explorer becomes locked, as opposed to un-locked, or open, when you are moving from site to site.

While using SSL encryption to protect sensitive information online, we also protect user-information off-line. All of our users' information, not just the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in our offices. Only personnel who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to the identifiable information. Servers that store the information are in a secure environment.
